

DRAFT BEER

RADEBERGER PILSNER

From the first brewery in Germany to brew pilsner in its traditional manner back in 1872, this crisp, fluffy-headed golden lager is brisk in bitterness and mellow in malt.

4.8% ABV (RADEBERG, GERMANY) 1/2 L: 7 L: 13 P: 18

ARCOBRÄU ZWICKLBIER

Unfiltered lager with slight yeast-hazed golden hue yields faint aromas of pepper, fresh-cut grass and bread. Taste of dry grain and light, nutty yeast.

5.2% ABV (MOOS, GERMANY) 1/2 L: 7 L: 13 P: 18

BLANCHE DE BRUXELLES

This pale gold witbier with a cloudy and gorgeous tall crop of snow-white head is really not like any other beer. Its natural spice aromas of coriander and bitter orange peel are added during the brewing process. Just sip it.

4.5% ABV (BRUSSELS, BELGIUM) 1/2 L: 7 L: 13 P: 18

BROUCZECH DARK

Reddish-brown in color with a rich, foamy, caramel head and a distinctive aroma of roasted malt and Saaz hops. Although on the sweeter side, it still retains its typically pleasant hoppy-malty tail.

5% ABV (NOVÁ PAKA, CZECH REPUBLIC) 1/2 L: 7 L: 13 P: 18

HOFBRAU DUNKEL

First type of beer brewed in Hofbräuhaus when founded in 1589. Malty and full-bodied, with notes of cocoa yet not a heavy lager, the HB Dunkel is a real classic.

5.5% ABV (MUNICH, GERMANY) 1/2 L: 7 L: 13 P: 18

FRANZISKANER DUNKEL-WEISSE

Dark wheat with aromas of clove and banana similar to a hefeweizen with a bit less citrus scent. The addition of darker roasted malts adds pleasant aromatics, a deep ruby color and a more complex flavor.

5% ABV (MUNICH, GERMANY) 1/2 L: 7 L: 13 P: 18

FRANZISKANER HEFE-WEISSE

Naturally cloudy, classic unfiltered hefeweizen. Expect notes of clove, banana and faint citrus in the aroma, yeasty bread-like flavor and a mildly spicy finish.

5% ABV (MUNICH, GERMANY) 1/2 L: 7 L: 13 P: 18

GAFFEL KÖLSCH

Delicately bitter, pleasant and slightly hoppy, this kölsch style ale is fermented with ale yeast but matured at cooler "lagering" temperatures to combine an ale's fruity complexity with a lager's crispness.

4.8% ABV (COLOGNE, GERMANY) 1/2 L: 7 L: 13 P: 18

HACKER-PSCHORR OKTOBERFEST

One of the six original Oktoberfest beers permitted, a traditional Bavarian clear Festbier with a rich amber color, full body and rich, creamy head. A classic Bavarian Märzen style.

5.8% ABV (MUNICH, GERMANY) 1/2 L: 7 L: 13 P: 18

HOFBRÄU MÜNCHEN ORIGINAL

Embodies the special atmosphere of the beer-making capital of Munich, which exports it to the four corners of the globe. Full-bodied yet not robust, a well-balanced beer where the hops, yeast and malt are in harmony.

5.1% ABV (MUNICH, GERMANY) 1/2 L: 7 L: 13 P: 18

KÖSTRITZER

This king of the German schwarzbiers has been a steadfast champion among rich, dark beers. Spiked with chocolate, roasted nut and coffee flavors, it is often regarded as Germany's version of Guinness.

5.6% ABV (THÜRINGEN, GERMANY) 1/2 L: 7 L: 13 P: 18

PALM

Belgium's #1 amber ale. Palm's special house yeast and malts from the Champagne district of France deliver a faint citrusy nose, a caramel, malty body and a very clean finish. This "Speciale Belge" is well-balanced, light and refreshing.

5.4% ABV (STEENHUFFEL, BELGIUM) 1/2 L: 7 L: 13 P: 18

PAULANER ORIGINAL MÜNCHNER HELL

The world's best-selling Munich lager and, some would argue, the finest. This Helles-style lager imparts toffee and apple aromas with buttery cookies on the palate.

4.9% ABV (MUNICH, GERMANY) 1/2 L: 7 L: 13 P: 18

PAULANER SALVATOR

Brewed by monks since 1634, this first-ever strong beer – also called "liquid bread" – was so good, it was sent to Rome for a papal blessing. This legendary liquid is majestically malty, nutty with a deliciously dry finish.

7.9% ABV (MUNICH, GERMANY) 1/2 L: 7 L: 13 P: 18

PILSENER HAUS ORIGINAL

Pale and crystal-clear with a dense, foamy head. Floral notes and some faint honey sweetness on the back of the tongue make this a light and effortlessly drinkable pils.

4.8% ABV (GERMANY) 1/2 L: 7 L: 13 P: 18

PILSNER URQUELL

"The Original since 1842." The grandfather of the world's most popular style – pilsner. A deep, burnished gold with a spicy floral Saaz hop and complex maltiness.

4.4% ABV (PILSEN, CZECH REPUBLIC) 1/2 L: 7 L: 13 P: 18

RAMSTEIN (SEASONALS)

From local High Point Brewery, Ramstein lagers and seasonal specialty beers are consistently rated to be among the very best in the world.

4.9% ABV (BUTLER, NJ) 1/2 L: 7 L: 13 P: 18

SPATEN DUNKEL

This old-fashioned Bavarian dunkel ("dark" in German) pours with a deep, tea-brown color and traditionally clean aroma, with traces of pumpernickel, caramel and nuts.

5.5% ABV (MUNICH, GERMANY) 1/2 L: 7 L: 13 P: 18

STIEGL

Once a favorite of Mozart's, this full-bodied, well-rounded golden lager shows a typical European bouquet, magnificent head and pleasant, thirst-quenching finish.

4.9% ABV (SALZBURG, AUSTRIA) 1/2 L: 7 L: 13 P: 18

WEIHENSTEPHANER HEFEWEIZEN

From the world's oldest and most legendary brewery at Weihenstephan, Germany comes this heavenly, unfiltered wheat beer with a big bready base, filled with banana, toffee and tropical fruit. Drink it – it's a world classic.

5.4% ABV (FREISING, GERMANY) 1/2 L: 7 L: 13 P: 18

AMERICAN CRAFT BOTTLES

AMBER ALES

LONG TRAIL DOUBLE BAG Strong ale with a full, rich, malty body, balanced by 3 generous additions of noble hops.

7.2% ABV (BRIDGEWATER CORNERS, VT) 6

TOMMYKNÖCKER MAPLE NUT BROWN ALE A nut brown ale with a sweet malt overtone from being brewed with maple syrup.

4.5% ABV (IDAHO SPRINGS, CO) 6

TRÖEGS HOPBACK AMBER Packed full of whole flower hops, creating a fresh hoppy aroma, spicy taste and rich caramel note.

6% ABV (HARRISBURG, PA) 6

WHEAT BEERS

SOUTHAMPTON DOUBLE WHITE Unfiltered wheat ale with a big malt mouthfeel combined with overtones of coriander and orange peel.

6.7% ABV (SOUTHAMPTON, NY) 6

ITHACA APRICOT WHEAT Unique wheat beer finished with subtle fresh apricot.

4.9% ABV (ITHACA, NY) 6

ALLAGASH WHITE Naturally cloudy, bottled with yeast, this traditional Belgian wit delicately balances full flavor with a crisp, refreshing taste and subtle hints of spice.

5.5% ABV (PORTLAND, ME) 6

CIDER

WOODPECKER ENGLISH CIDER A crisp semi-dry finish, amber hue with a lightly sparkling appearance, sweet fruity aroma and a slight toffee-apple note.

4.2% ABV (UK) 6

PALE ALES

FLYING FISH EXTRA PALE ALE Straw-colored with subtle flavors and aromas.

4.8% ABV (CHERRY HILL, NJ) 6

VICTORY HEADWATERS PALE ALE An upfront citrus hop nose with rich German malt character, finished with Simcoe hops.

5.2% ABV (DOWNTOWN, PA) 6

AVERY ELLIE'S BROWN ALE Crystal and chocolate malts give this beer a brown sugar maltiness with hints of vanilla and nuts.

5.5% ABV (BOULDER, CO) 6

IPA'S

FIRESTONE WALKER DOUBLE JACK Imperial IPA, characterized by a huge citrus hop profile balanced with a major malt character.

9.5% ABV (PASO ROBLES, CA) 11

NECTAR ALES NECTAR IPA A flowery hop aroma leading to a caramel malt presence, finishing with a hop flavor to the end.

6.8% ABV (PASO ROBLES, CA) 6

DOGFISH HEAD 60 MIN East Coast IPA with a lot of citrusy hop character. The session beer for beer geeks.

6% ABV (MILTON, DE) 6

STONE IPA The result of a unique brewing process—two extra weeks of “dry-hopping”—which creates this beer's crisp and refreshingly bitter character.

6.9% ABV (ESCONDIDO, CA) 6

PORTERS AND STOUTS

DOGFISH HEAD WORLD WIDE STOUT This imperial stout is most definitely a sipping beer, with dark chocolate/ coffee taste and bitterness on the sides of your tongue.

18% ABV (MILTON, DE) 18

WOLAVER'S OATMEAL STOUT USDA-certified organic, sweet, with hints of coffee, chocolate and roasted rolled oats.

5.9% ABV (MIDDLEBURY, VT) 6

LEFT HAND MILK STOUT The milk sugar adds well-rounded sweetness to this dark beer, making it an outstanding year-round stout.

5.3% ABV (LONGMONT, CO) 6

FLYING DOG GONZO IMPERIAL PORTER Like Hunter S. Thompson, Gonzo Imperial Porter is deep and complex. With its high ABV, it will bite you in the ass if you don't show it the proper respect.

9.2% ABV (FREDERICK, MD) 7

OSKAR BLUES TEN FIDY A wonder of a stout, immensely viscous and loaded with neck-deep flavors of chocolate, malt, coffee, cocoa and oats.

10.5% ABV (LYONS, CO) 11

LAGER

BROOKLYN LAGER This dry-hopped, fresh, flowery lager is brewed to a pre-Prohibition recipe dating back to when Brooklyn was the brewing capital of the East Coast.

5.2% ABV (BROOKLYN, NY) 6

BELGIAN-STYLE TRIPEL

VICTORY GOLDEN MONKEY Brewed in the Belgian Abbey style, with a golden hue and complex, intriguing blends of spices and aromas.

9.5% ABV (DOWNTOWN, PA) 6

FIRESTONE WALKER 10

Blend of barleywine, imperial stout, imperial brown and double IPA, aged in Old Fitzgerald barrels.

10% ABV (PASO ROBLES, CA) 8

ANCHOR CHRISTMAS ALE

Special deep amber ale with a bouquet of spices, toasted malts and slight hop bitterness. The 37th new recipe in as many years.

6.2% ABV (SAN FRANCISCO, CA) 6

SOUTHAMPTON IMPERIAL PORTER

This imperial, Baltic-style porter is rich and flavorful with upfront notes of chocolate, caramel and toffee.

7.2% ABV (SOUTHAMPTON, NY) 6

VICTORY YAKIMA GLORY

Aromatic hops from Washington State brighten the deep flavors of the malts for a complex satisfaction with a warming edge.

8.7% ABV (DOWNTOWN, PA) 8

IMPORTED BOTTLES

AECHT SCHLENKERLA RAUCHBIER MÄRZEN Dark, bottom-fermented smokebeer, brewed with Original Schlenkerla Smokemalt and tapped from the gravity-fed oakwood cask in the historic brewery tavern.

5.1% ABV (BAMBERG, GERMANY) 9

ALVINNE PUDGE BELGIAN IMPERIAL STOUT Deeply complex beer brewed with 4 different yeast strains. It blurs the line between imperial stout and Belgian Tripel.

10.5% ABV (HEULE, BELGIUM) 9

AUGUSTINER EDELSTOFF Golden helles/pils hybrid with an easy balance of sweet malt and citrus hops. High-class product of the old Bavarian brewing art. Widely popular among the young hipster and artsy Munich crowd.

5.6% ABV (MUNICH, GERMANY) 6

AYINGER CELEBRATOR DOPPELBOCK Rich, dark elixir with cascading layers of malt complexity balanced by elegant hops. Notes of toffee, caramel, elegant dark malt and roastiness.

6.7% ABV (AYING, GERMANY) 10

B. NEKTAR MEADERY Wonderful citrus aromas dominate and are followed up with smooth honey character and nice acidity.

13% ABV (FERNDALE, MI) 25

BOON OUDE GEUZE The “Champagne of Brussels” is a 100% spontaneously fermented lambic, aged for 2 years in oak barrels.

6.5% ABV (LEMBEEK, BELGIUM) 10

DUCHESSE DE BOURGOGNE Also known as “The Burgundy of Belgium,” it is a blend of 8- and 18-month-old ales following careful maturation in oak casks. 100% natural and unpasteurized.

6.2% ABV (VICHTE, BELGIUM) 9

DUVEL TRIPEL HOP Limited release made with 3 kinds of hops—Styrian Goldings, Saaz and Amarillo. Dry-hopped with more Styrian and an extra dose of malts to hold up.

9.5% ABV (BREENDONK-PUURS, BELGIUM) 25

EINBECKER NON-ALCOHOLIC Full-flavored connoisseur's beer brewed in the pilsner style, whereby the alcohol is carefully extracted after maturing.

0.3% ABV (EINBECK, GERMANY) 5

GREEN'S DISCOVERY Gluten-free ale with a dense head that retains body remarkably well. Nice interplay of hoppy bitterness and sweetness in the finish.

6% ABV (BILDON SHIPLEY, ENGLAND) 9

HARVIESTOUN OLD ENGINE OIL Wickedly smooth chocolate dominates, nicely balanced by the bitterness of the hops. Derived from a 1970s homebrewing recipe.

6% ABV (ALVA, SCOTLAND) 9

J.W. LEES HARVEST ALE Brewed once a year, this is a limited-edition Vintage. Pale in color, good deal of malty flavors on the palate. Aged in Lagavulin casks for 4 months.

11.5% ABV (MANCHESTER, ENGLAND) 24

LA CHOUFFE Golden ale, spicy, lightly hoppy with evolving taste. Bottle re-fermented and unfiltered.

8% ABV (ACHOUFFE, BELGIUM) 9

LA RULLÈS TRIPLE Orange color, with a medium body that is surprisingly creamy. The nose and taste both show a spicy fruitiness with hints of citrus and honey.

8.4% ABV (RULLES, BELGIUM) 10

LINDEMANS FRAMBOISE LAMBIC Magnificent aroma and a delicate palate of raspberries with undertones of fruity acidity define this beer.

4% ABV (VLEZENBEEK, BELGIUM) 10

LINDEMANS PÊCHE LAMBIC Exceptional aroma and a delicate palate of peaches with undertones of fruity acidity define this beer.

4% ABV (VLEZENBEEK, BELGIUM) 10

MALHEUR 10 Re-fermented and bottle-conditioned Belgian Ale with gold color, honey-like texture and slightly hoppy-dry aftertaste.

10% ABV (BUGGENHOUT, BELGIUM) 9

MAREDSOUS BRUNE This elegantly complex Abbey Dubbel is full of flavors of dried fruit, plum and a mild smokiness with faint aromas of molasses, anise and ripe, dark fruits.

8% ABV (BREENDONK-PUURS, BELGIUM) 8

ORVAL A Trappist Ale with a yeast strain that leads to superb dry complexity. Sunset-orange color, fruity and slightly acidic bouquet.

6.9% ABV (VILLERS-DEVANT-ORVAL, BELGIUM) 9

PINKUS ORGANIC UR PILS From the world's first certified organic brewery comes this pils, pale in color with flavors of honey, raw barley, wheat and oatmeal.

5.2% ABV (MÜNSTER, GERMANY) 7

ROCHEFORT 8 Hard to resist this cherry nose and full-bodied fruitcake character, silky treacle texture and dry cider apple finish. Flavorful, vigorous, complex.

9.2% ABV (ROCHEFORT, BELGIUM) 10

RODENBACH CLASSIC This legendary Flemish sour red ale is a result of long maturation in oak tuns. A blend of 75% young beer fermented in steel tanks and 25% old beer aged 2 years in large oak casks.

5.2% ABV (ROESELARE, BELGIUM) 7

SAISON DUPONT A pleasing pale straw color with a dense, creamy head. Full-bodied and malty, it sparkles on the palate and finishes with a zesty hop and citrus attack.

6.5% ABV (TOURPES-LEUZE, BELGIUM) 9

SCHNEIDER AVENTINUS Dark ruby in color, clove-like aroma, full-bodied palate with a hint of caramel and a light, delicate, bitter finish.

8.2% ABV (KELHEIM, GERMANY) 9

SCHNEIDER WIESEN EDEL-WEISSE A huge white head that slowly reduces but never completely dies. The aroma is banana and clove with some ginger and a faint metallic smell. Organic.

6.2% ABV (KELHEIM, GERMANY) 9

ST. BERNARDUS TRIPEL Pale amber color and a flowery, fruity taste with harmonious balance between sweet and sour.

8% ABV (WATOU, BELGIUM) 9

UNIBROU LA FIN DU MONDE “The end of the world.” A bottle-conditioned beer, triple fermented through a blend of special yeasts, giving this malt beverage an exquisitely robust flavor.

9% ABV (CHAMBLAY, CANADA) 8

WESTMALLE TRIPEL A glowing orange bold color, herbal aroma and complex flavors make this ale truly a connoisseur's Trappist classic.

9.5% ABV (MALLE, BELGIUM) 9

ŽATEC DARK LAGER Fairly full-bodied, this lager has a clean malt flavor and aroma with pure notes of dark bread, caramel and a suggestion of toffee.

5.7% ABV (ŽATEC, CZECH REPUBLIC) 7
